Competency-Based Clinical Supervision:

Competences and How These Translate into Supervision Practice.

Supervision as a distinct professional practice is fast-evolving with new innovations and standards of practice developing quickly. This course is designed to provide participants a framework of competency-based supervision, including the most current view of evolving practices of clinical supervision. Content includes a review of targeted areas of supervisory skill to focus on enhanced assessment of efficacy, technique, and practice. Outcome is an essential component, both outcome of clients and of the supervisory process and will be targeted. Lecture, discussion, videos and experiential exercises are included.

The Role of the Supervisor in Regulation of Competence-Based Supervision.

Clinical supervisors hold multiply potentially conflictual roles. Implicit in the role is the development of a secure supervisory alliance in which supervisees disclose multiple aspects such as clinical errors, emotional responses to clients, and countertransference. In addition, supervisors are evaluators, teachers, protectors of the clients and ultimately gatekeepers for the profession. A superordinate value is integrity and ethics-based practice as it is incumbent on the supervisor to function with the highest level of each. Multiple areas of ethics will be discussed as well as the supervisory multiple roles and strategies to maximize effectiveness
