Childhood Trauma and Brain Development - The Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics

Dr. Perry is an outstanding, innovative clinician and researcher in mental health and the neurosciences. The development of a young child is profoundly influenced by experience. Experiences shape brain organization which, in turn, influences emotional, social, cognitive & physiological development. Insights into this process come from understanding brain development. The Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics NMT is a developmentally sensitive, neurobiologically-informed approach to clinical problem solving. NMT integrates core principles of neurodevelopment and traumatology to inform work with children, families & communities.
