Evocation – Empowering Therapeutic Communication

Dr. Jeffrey K. Zeig has spent a lifetime evolving Evocative Psychotherapy. In Evocation, he continues an exploration that began decades ago as he sought to trace and to expand upon the nuances and applications of Milton Erickson's extraordinary work. Turning to the original masters of evocative communication, painters, composers, filmmakers, poets, choreographers, he demystifies the grammar of the artist's expression, teaching how to use it to enhance and empower therapeutic communication. Evocative Psychotherapy relies on a central belief: *Therapy at its best, whatever the paradigm, invites shared awakening rather than relying on data delivery.*

This seminar includes live demonstration of Evocative Psychotherapy.

Communication is both evocative and informative. Dr. Zeig claims that if you want to evoke an alteration in conceptual realization or state, you need to use evocative communication that tends to be unusual. To understand science, which is based on facts, informative communication is necessary. But the symbolism and ambiguities inherent to art are fundamental to eliciting emotions and concomitant states. Dr. Zeig will teach us why therapists need evocative training to enter the therapist states of utilization, orienting toward, and being strategic, and why therapists also need to be trained to evocatively communicate.

Jeffrey K. Zeig PhD is the Founder and Director of the Milton H. Erickson Foundation. He has edited, co-edited, authored, or coauthored more than 20 books on psychotherapy. Dr. Zeig is on the Editorial Board of numerous journals and is a Fellow

of the American Psychological Association and the American Society of Clinical Hypnosis. As a psychologist and marriage and family therapist in private practice in Phoenix, Arizona, Dr. Zeig conducts workshops internationally. He is the president of Zeig, Tucker & Theisen, Inc., publishers in the behavioral sciences.
