**Invitation: Seminar on Intercultural Psychology:**

**“Diversity Management in Academic Teaching of Intercultural Psychology in Denmark /Europe”**

**Friday the 10<sup>th</sup> of April 2015 from 10 am until 5 pm at Roskilde University, Roskilde.**

In the future an increasing number of people including psychologists will be working in a multicultural context both in Denmark and abroad, which means that the acquisition of intercultural knowledge, competences and skills will be even more important than at present.

During this seminar we will collect information about what currently is taking place at the universities at within the field of cultural and intercultural psychology. Furthermore, we will discuss programs which can provide reciprocal inspiration as well as inspire other educational institutions. Also, present possibilities of exchange, collaboration and synergies can be brought up during the seminar.

The overall objective of the seminar is to create a forum in which Intercultural Psychology, Transcultural Psychology and Cultural Psychology, in education and practice, can be presented, debated and developed.

The seminar will consist of presentations by educators from different universities on Intercultural Psychology. This will be followed by the keynote speaker Ulrike de Ponte, Regensburg, Germany. She will discuss a study programme in Intercultural Psychology and ethnic diversity. Afterwards experienced practitioners will facilitate workshops on practices related to Intercultural Psychology.
